MURRAY RIVER CRUISE

9 to 15 August 2026



With all the character and charm of yesteryear, the Murray Princess is an authentic paddle-wheeler built to cruise the mighty Murray River. It's a real taste of bygone days; with the elegance and convenience you'd expect today.

Day 1 - Sunday 9 August 2026 This morning your holiday starts with a home pick up (Brisbane Metropolitan Area) to take you to Brisbane Domestic Airport in plenty of time to catch your Virgin flight to Adelaide. On arrival in Adelaide transfer to your overnight accommodation. Free time in Adelaide this afternoon – take a stroll through the Botanic Gardens or visit Rundall Street Pedestrian Mall with many interesting shops. While at the mall take time to appreciate the mall artwork like the Rundle Pigs and Mall's Balls. Haighs Chocolate shop is a must visit. Day 1 – 1 Night Adelaide

Day 2 - Monday 10 August 2026 After breakfast there will be free time before our coach transfer to Mannan (about 75 minutes) to join the Murray Princess, sailing at 4-30 p.m. Settle into your outside cabin (with ensuite) which opens onto the outside deck hallway with picture windows to view the spectacular passing scenery. A welcome dinner will be served as we head upriver under floodlight to our overnight mooring at Caoramont. Under floodlight you may see nocturnal wildlife on the riverbank. Watch for kangaroos, hairy-nosed wombats, tortoises, egrets and many other species. An on-board entertainer will provide music for night owls. Day 2 – Murray Princess – Breakfast & Dinner

Day 3 - Tuesday 11 August 2026 At daybreak it's time for the keen photographers to be out and about to capture the special light and the morning movement of wildlife. Prolific birdlife includes pelicans, wrens and swans. Enjoy a leisurely morning and lunch cruising upriver to Blanchetown through one of 13 locks which maintain the flow and levels of the river's water. This afternoon we moor opposite to the township of Blanchetown for our evening anchorage. As the last rays of the sun fade, we visit Burk Salter Boutique Winery and enjoy wine tasting at the cellar door which is fitted out with beautiful red gum bars. After dinner, join in on all the fun and excitement, and participate in the 'Murray River Cup'. Day 3 – Murray Princess – Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 4 - Wednesday 12 August 2026 After breakfast we cruise downriver to picturesque Swan Reach. The town was first settled in the 1850's, was originally the largest of five sheep and cattle stations in the area and is now home to native flower and fruit growers. The original Swan Reach homestead is now the Swan Reach Hotel where you can enjoy an ale or cappuccino overlooking the Murray River (own expense). Join a walking tour and visit the Swan Reach Museum (gold coin donation on entry). Cruise downriver after lunch and take in the tranquillity as the landscape slides by. When we arrive at Sunnydale, it's all ashore for the Woolshed Show as we recreate typical Australian woolshed history. Later we visit the Native Wildlife Shelter where some of South Australia's most interesting native animals are cared for. Then, course, there is the great Aussie Barbecue – cooked and served in a bush setting on the banks of the mighty Murray River. Optional Tour – Sunnydale Nocturnal Tour – additional cost – bookings can be made on board through your Passenger Services Attendant. Day 4 – Murray Princess – Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 5 - Thursday 13 August 2026 After an optional early morning Bush Tucker breakfast (additional cost) or bush walk with the captain, the vessel cruises slowly downriver past magnificent cliffs scoured by the river over millions of years. We reach Ngaut Ngaut Conservation Park, one of Australia's most significant archaeological sites, for a step back in time (tens of thousands of years) and a guided boardwalk tour to view ancient rock carvings and to learn about Aboriginal history in the area. We return to the vessel to cruise downriver to Youngusband. Along the way, adventure seekers can also take a scenic tender boat ride. Tonight, join your fellow passengers for a delicious final night dinner. Day 5 – Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 6 - Friday 14 August 2026 This morning we leave Youngusband and head back to Mannum. After breakfast we reluctantly say farewell as we arrive at the Mannum Wharf. Leaving Mannum by coach we return to Adelaide by about 11 a.m. Hotel check in may not be for a couple of hours allowing time to perhaps visit the Adelaide Central Markets for lunch. Day 6 – Breakfast

Day 7 - Saturday 15 August 2026 Breakfast will be served at our hotel before travelling to the airport for our return flight to Brisbane. Arriving in Brisbane we will be met and driven home.

Murray Princess Accommodation

Outside Cabins are located on Randell and Cadell Decks and the majority of these cabins have twin bedding with limited double-bedded cabins available. Each outside cabin opens onto the outside deck walkway with picture windows.

Ghan Accommodation

Twin Gold Cabin: The most popular choice, offering a comfortable private cabin with a three-seater lounge that converts to upper and lower sleeping berths. Includes a compact en-suite, in-cabin music and journey commentary channels, and access to the Queen Adelaide Restaurant.

Gold Single Cabin: Designed for solo travellers, with a single bed that converts to a comfortable seat by day, private vanity, and shared bathroom facilities at either end of the carriage and access to the Queen Adelaide Restaurant.
